Why Bonding Is The Best Time

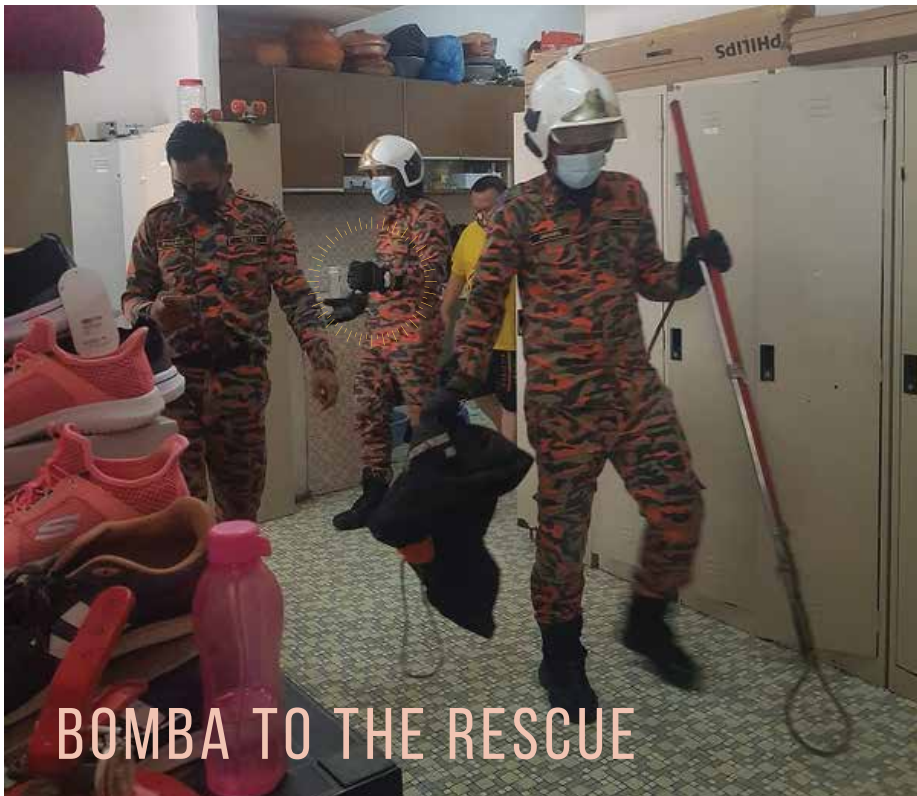
Scientists believe that strong ties between parent and their child provide their child's first model for intimate relationships, foster a sense of security and positive self-esteem.

Can you see the obvious smiles and energy from our little kids here?

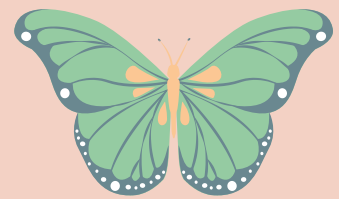
Yes, their favourite is the Vitamin C gummies! They eat their gummies very, very slowly because they treasure them loads!

Aren't we proud of them!

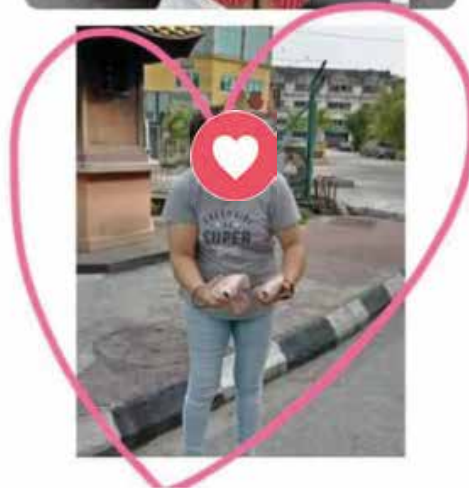


The Kitchen Work Amounts to Big Efforts

Months ago, her behaviour started to change for the worst, because of certain stress that she experienced.

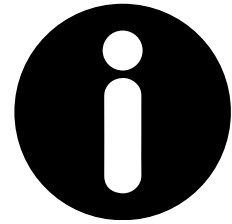
We then started to call her in for a counselling session, and prayed with her.
